

Walks

Surrounded by 2,000 acres of beautiful countryside with glittering lakes and streams, you are in a rambler's paradise.

Fawsley to the Church of St Mary - under 1 mile

We are lucky enough to be surrounded by an abundance of parkland landscaped by Capability Brown, with manicured gardens and glittering lakes. To give you a feel of the landscape without going too far, take a stroll down the hill to St Mary's Church, where you will find one of the lakes to the right.

Fawsley to Badby - approx. 2.3 miles

With its ironstone cottages, thatched roofs and village greens, the lovely village of Badby is said to be one of the prettiest in the county. Choose either of the routes on this useful map for a pleasant walk into Badby, including the Knightley Trail, with places to look out for on the way.

Badby Woods - various routes

Found on the way to Badby from Fawsley Hall, and owned by the Fawsley Estate, Badby Woods is open to the public and is famous for its Bluebells. You enter the wood through what is left of a fantastic gatehouse. These woods are also a Site of Special Scientific Interest.

Everdon Stubbs – various routes 🖨 4 miles from Fawsley Hall

A 72 acre ancient woodland with a mix of English and sessile oak, lowland birch, sweet chestnut and sycamore. A prehistoric Saxon burial site remains on the site's northern boundary along with a host of other archaeological features found across the woodland. Various routes can be <u>found here</u>.

Drayton Reservoir – 8k circular route 8 miles from Fawsley Hall
This reservoir is popular with the local angling community and is a picturesque place for a walk. The circular route is 8k, although various routes can be found here.

Daventry Country Park - 5k circular route 7 miles from Fawsley Hall
There are circular, way-marked trails through the woodlands and meadows that
surround the reservoir, with bird hides to stop and view the wildlife. With an
adventure playground, outdoor gym equipment, numerous picnic spots, a nature
trail and a wealth of wildlife, Daventry Country Park is a great family day out.





Family Trips

From the educational to the inspirational, you will find plenty of fun for all the family.

Tiger's Indoor Play - 6 miles away

Tiger's Indoor Play is one of the region's largest indoor play centres. With NO time limit, Tiger's is suitable for children aged 0-12 years, with activities including a four-lane astra slide, a thrilling zip wire, a large sports area for football and the largest cargo net climb in the country!

Whilton Mill - 9 miles away

Northamptonshire's premier Kart track! But it's not just all about Karts - Whilton Mill offers a whole range of activities, from quad bikes and clay pigeon shooting to off-road buggies, archery and hovercraft.

Silverstone - 12 miles away

The home of British motor racing, visit Silverstone circuit for full-throttle events and track days. Explore the interactive museum to discover the stars, stories and science behind the sport.

The Pinnacle Climbing Centre - 16 miles

The Pinnacle Climbing Centre is passionate about the vertical arena and equally as passionate about introducing non-climbers to a life away from the ground. Its climbing halls have over 200 routes up to 12.5 meters high and its bouldering room has over 70 problems. All ages are catered for.

Stratford Butterfly Farm - 29 miles away

The UK's largest tropical butterfly paradise. Come rain or shine, enjoy the unique pleasure of discovering hundreds of the world's most beautiful butterflies!

Hatton Country World - 29 miles away

Hatton Country World is a fantastic farm park and shopping village filled with animals to feed, adventure play areas, indoor soft play areas, children's shows, independent gift shops, antique centre, café and much more.


Santa Pod Raceway - 34 miles away

Canons Ashby - 6 miles away

The National Trust's tranquil Canons Ashby is an Elizabethan manor house and 18th century rare terraced gardens, with the 'ancient' Dryden family at its heart.

Althorp Estate - 13 miles away

Showcasing one of Europe's finest private collections of furniture, paintings and ceramics, each intriguing room of this magnificent family home has a fascinating story of its own.

Bicester Village - 30 miles away
